 - "I will redeem you" God's Promise of Purpose
 - o "I will make you my people" God's Promise of Fulfillment

Optional Questions – If needed, include one or more of these scriptures and questions to extend your conversation.

- "The Cross Is God's Plan A & There Is No Plan B." From the creation story, through Passover and into the life of Jesus we see God's plan at work from the start. How did God move in your life <u>before</u> you chose to follow Him?
- Read Proverbs 14:12 aloud. If you could see the outcome of every choice you make before making it, how would it change the way you live? Have you ever found yourself on the wrong path? What did you do?
- Read Deuteronomy 30:19-20 aloud. What do you find most compelling about these verses? Why?
- Read Proverbs 3:5-6 aloud. Ps Blake share that the best approach to walking down the right path and finishing well is to lean into Jesus. How would you explain this verse to a friend?
