 - Share the best thing about this Easter.
 - o One of your favorite Easter memories or traditions.

Key Questions

- What's one idea from Sunday's message that really stood out to you? Why did this grab your attention?
- "What You See Depends On Where You Stand." Ps Blake shared about three different perspectives of the empty tomb. The empty tomb is an event, an experience and an invitation. How does a persons standing with God impact the way they see these three empty tomb perspectives?
- "Easter Is An Invitation to Stand In An Empty Tomb To See A Full Life In Christ." The Resurrection changes things. Not only did it change the disciples' lives; the realization of it changes our lives today. What is the biggest way Jesus' resurrection has changed you personally?

Optional Questions – If needed, include one or more of these scriptures and questions to extend your conversation.

- "God didn't just open the tomb to change what you see but to change where you stand." How did you answer the last question of the Easter Survey? How can this group encourage you to take your next step into the power of the empty tomb? What would stop you from going "All In" like Peter?
- Read John 20:1-8 aloud. In this passage John is recounting his experience at the empty tomb. What sticks out to you most from this passage? Why?
- Read John 20:10 aloud. After experiencing the empty tomb Peter and John returned to the same situation, but with a new perspective. What are you asking God for a new perspective of in your life? Spend some time sharing and encouraging each other.
- Read 1 Corinthians 15:19 aloud. What sticks out to you most from this passage? Do you agree with the Apostle Paul? Why or why not?
