Optional Questions – If needed, include one or more of these scriptures and questions to extend your conversation.

- "Everyone needs 4 or more Christian friends to grow with." We all need a friend ahead of us, friends beside us, and a friend behind us. Who are you pouring into in this season of your life? Do you feel like God has asked you to develop the potential in someone? What have you learned from that experience?
- Read Hebrews 6:1-2 aloud. Before the #adulting series would you have listed these 6 principles as the "elementary" principles of our faith? Why or why not? Do any of these teachings seem out of place to you?
- Read 2 Timothy 1:5-7 aloud. This passage shows the practical and spiritual impact of the laying on of hands. Timothy was a result of the women in his family and Paul's ministry. Who has God used to help shape you into the person you are today?
- Read Romans 2:4 aloud. What sticks out to you from this verse? Why?
