## **Getting Started**

## **Key Questions**

- **Recap:** What's one spiritual truth from this week's "At The Movies" that really stood out to you? Why did this grab your attention?
- **Big Idea:** *"God has and continues to call and equip whomever He chooses to accomplish His purposes."* God often calls people that others consider not worthy.
  - Do you believe that God can choose to use anyone to accomplish his purpose? Why?
- **Next Step:** *"Each local church must prayerfully follow the leadership of the Holy Spirit under the direction of the full counsel of God's Word to determine who should teach and lead in each season of ministry."*
  - There isn't always a clear cut answer in scripture and sometimes we must prayerfully consider what God's direction is.
  - How do we wrestle with a piece of scripture that we don't fully understand right now?
    - What are you prayerfully considering right now?

**Optional Questions** – *If needed, include one or more of these scriptures and questions to extend your conversation.*

- Read Genesis 1:27 aloud. This passage talks about how both men and women were made in the image of God. How do men and women compliment each other to represent God's image? Is it important to maintain their uniqueness?
- Read Galatians 3:28 aloud. God makes all of us equal in Jesus. With this equality, why is it important we pursue His unique calling in our own life?
- Read Esther 4:14 aloud. Esther, and other women in the Bible, have been crucial in advancing God's kingdom. What's one way you've been impacted positively by a godly woman following God's calling in her life?
