- Welcome & Prayer

Key Questions

- **Recap:** What's one spiritual truth from this week's message that really stood out to you? Why did this grab your attention?
- **Big Idea:** *"Don't ask what God can do for me, but what can God do through me?"*
 - On Sunday, Pastor Blake shared that God has something he wants to do through all of us to help others, not simply to let it stop with us.
 - Why is it more important to ask what God wants to do through us?
 - Pastor Blake shared the three ways we can allow God to move through us
 - Be Spirit-led
 - When was a time you allowed the spirit to lead you?
 - Be Vision-Focused
 - What does it mean to you to be vision-focused?
 - Be A Multiplier
 - Being a multiplier requires us to lead. How can you begin leading where you are at right now?
- **Next Steps:** *"As a church, we've been called to Own The Map and reach the places where other churches can't."*
 - On Sunday, Pastor Blake shared the vision for 200 neighborhood churches.
 - Do you believe that everyone needs a church family to call home? Why?
 - What benefits come from having a church family around you?

Optional Questions – *If needed, include one or more of these scriptures and questions to extend your conversation.*

- Read Luke 2:49 aloud. In this passage Jesus shares that His life to go about His Father's business.

- How does viewing what we do as partnering God in His business here on earth change things?
- How have you experienced this in your own life?
- Read John 15:15-16 aloud. God calls us friend and invites us to be a part of what he is doing.
 - How does it make you feel that God wants to partner with you to change the world around you? Why?
 - How can you begin partnering with Him today?
