      - What does it mean to be united in Jesus?
    - Find Freedom and Power In His Hand
      - How does diversity in the Church display God's glory?
    - Leave A Legacy
      - How can 2nd stick relationships help us leave a legacy?
- **Next Steps:** "We must learn to break the mirror and open our hand"
  - We must be intentional to build 2nd stick friendships with people who don't look like us.
    - Do you agree with this statement? Why?
    - What are some practical ways you can begin doing that this week?

• <u>Read Colossians 1:16-17 aloud.</u> In this passage, the writer talks about how all things were created through God and for Him.

- Has there been a time in your life when you saw God represented through diversity?
- <u>Read Ezekiel 37:22 aloud.</u> God does not desire His church to be splintered by differences.
  - o What does it look like to be one family despite our differences?
  - o How can we celebrate each other's uniqueness?
