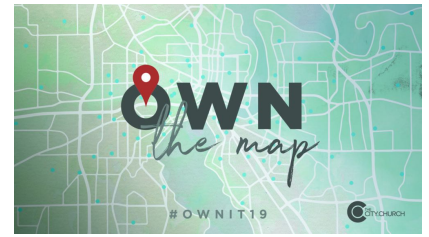


# Own The Map #OwnIt2019

## ***Getting Started***

- **Highs and Lows:** Ask your group what their high point and low point of the week
- **Icebreaker:** What are you thinking will be your word for 2019?

## ***Setup***

- Welcome & Prayer

## ***Key Questions***

- **Recap:** What's one spiritual truth from this week's message that really stood out to you? Why did this grab your attention?
- **Big Idea:** *"Ownership is taking by faith what God has given by grace"*
  - On Sunday, Pastor Blake shared that there is a tension in taking what God has already given to us
    - What does it mean to take something that God has already given? Why do we need faith to take it?
    - What are some things in your life that God has given you, but you have not yet taken?
  - Pastor Blake shared 3 ways you can make your map and begin taking what God has given
    - **Join God's Mission**
      - What does it mean to join God's mission, not just our own?
    - **Own Your Assignment**
      - How can we find God's assignment in our life?
    - **Fight For The Promise**
      - Why is it a fight to claim the promises God has given?
- **Next Steps:** *"We must be fully satisfied with our inheritance, and yet fight for all of it"*
  - God gave the promised land to the Israelites even though it was unconquered. Even though they still needed to fight, God was always in control.
    - What does it look like to have unconquered land in your life?
    - What are some areas that you need to begin fighting for?
      - How will you begin doing this?

**Optional Questions** – *If needed, include one or more of these scriptures and questions to extend your conversation.*

- Read Joshua 18:3 aloud. In this passage, Joshua is calling out the passivity of the Israelites because they have not moved to take the land God promised.
  - What does it look like to have a passive faith?
  - How can this impact what God wants to do through you?
  
- Read Joshua 18:6 aloud. God had a unique plot of land for each tribe.
  - Do you believe that God has a unique calling for your life?
  - What do you believe that calling is? How have you begun taking steps towards it?
