Key Questions

- **Recap:** What's your favorite part of being in a church family?
- **Big Idea:** *"Stop going to church, instead get planted in church."*
 - On Sunday, Pastor Blake shared that we were not called to simply "go" to church but that we need to be planted in church.
 - What does it mean to be planted in church? How can you do this at City.church?
 - What does it mean to flourish?
 - How has being planted in a church helped you flourish?
 - Pastor Blake shared 3 ways you can become planted in a church
 - Some Assembly Required
 - Why is it important to assemble with other believers regularly? What happens if we do not meet regularly?
 - Gather To Go
 - How does your church family empower you to go and reach the world around you for Christ?
 - Setup The Tent
 - Church is not about you. Do you agree with this? Why?
- Next Steps: "Deep root produce lasting fruits"
 - Pastor Blake talked about the importance of having deep roots in our spiritual life.
 - How do you establish deep roots in your church family?
 - How can you help others establish deep roots?
 - Why is it important to allow our roots to intertwine with our church families?

Optional Questions – If needed, include one or more of these scriptures and questions to extend your conversation.

- <u>Read Joshua 18:1 aloud.</u> In this passage, the writer is describing the Israelites current situation as they were preparing to flourish.
 - What area of your life are you currently waiting on God to help you flourish in?
 - What are some next steps you can take this week to get planted so God can make you flourish in your life?
