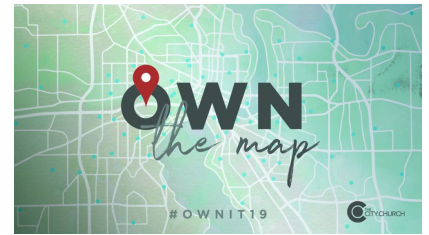

Getting Started

- **Highs and Lows:** Ask your group what their high point and low point of the week
- **Icebreaker:** If you had to eat one meal everyday for the rest of your life what would it be?

Setup

- Welcome & Prayer

Key Questions

- **Recap:** What's one idea that stood out to you from this Sunday's message? Why did that stand out to you?
- **Big Idea:** *"God's Calling You To Plant The Seed. Because Without You, Others Won't Get The Opportunity."*
 - On Sunday, Bradley shared our church's heart for being a people that see the value in planting seeds that benefit others.
 - How have other people's sacrifices helped you experience more in your life?
 - Bradley shared 3 ways we can be people who are like Moses and plant the seed.
 - **Carry God's Promise With Faith**
 - What does it mean to have faith? How do you define it?
 - Is there a promise in your life that you are having to have faith in because you are not seeing any movement?
 - **Choose Calling Over Comfort**
 - Do you believe that following God's calling in your life is often uncomfortable? Why?
 - Why is it important that we choose to not stay comfortable?
 - **Redefine Success**
 - What are your thoughts on the story of the "shells couple" Bob and Tina?
 - How does redefining success help you see with God's perspective?
- **Next Steps:** *"Choose To Plant The Seed."*

- Bradley asked that we be a church that eagerly chooses to sacrifice and plant the seed so that others may enjoy the fruit.
 - What is the difference between a consumer and a contributor?
 - Which one do you believe you are closer to being? Why?
 - What are some ways you can become even more of a contributor?
 - Has anyone thought through their word for 2019? Why did you choose that word?

Optional Questions – *If needed, include one or more of these scriptures and questions to extend your conversation.*

- Read Hebrews 11:27 aloud. In this passage, we see that Moses was able to carry the promise God gave him because he was focused on the right thing.
 - What does it practically look like to take our eyes off our situation and put them on God?
 - Why is it important to have faith in God to move and not in a specific way we expect Him to move?
