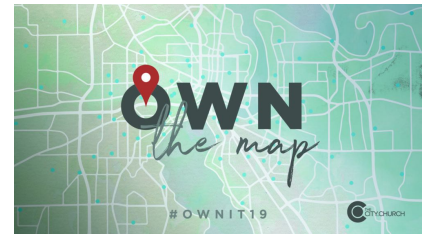


Own The Map #OwnIt2019

Getting Started

- **Highs and Lows:** Ask your group what their high point and low point of the week
- **Icebreaker:** What Is Your Favorite Thanksgiving Day Food?
- **Serve Day:** Spend time talking through and registering for Serve Day on Saturday

- Welcome & Prayer

Key Questions

- **Recap:** What's one idea that stood out to you from this Sunday's message? Why did that stand out to you?
- **Big Idea:** *"The Isrealites Needed A Map, And So Do We."*
 - On Sunday, Pastor Blake shared our church's map for beginning to multiply by growing personally.
 - What does being an Owner at TheCity.church mean to you?
 - Pastor Blake shared the 3 of the 5 faith elements that consist of being an Owner.
 - **Outreach**
 - Why is it important that we are continually focused on reaching others through outreach?
 - **Worship**
 - What role does regular worship serve in the life of an Owner? Why is it co crucial?
 - What does it mean for God to stir something inside of you?
 - **Next Steps**
 - What is the next step that you are currently trying to take?
- **Next Steps:** *"Now Is The Time To Own It"*
 - Pastor Blake talked about 3 of the various faith steps that we can be in.
 - Which of the 3 element sthat Blake covered on Sunday are the hardest for you to take?
 - How can we encourage you to take those steps?

- What is God calling you to Own during this season?

Optional Questions – *If needed, include one or more of these scriptures and questions to extend your conversation.*

- Read Proverbs 14:12 aloud. In this passage, the writer shares how we can be deceived and move in a direction we think is correct when it really is not.
 - Have you experienced this in your life? How did you realize you were going in the wrong direction?
 - How can we protect ourselves from being deceived like this in our lives?
