Getting Started

Key Questions

- **Recap:** What's one idea that stood out to you from this Sunday's message? Why did that stand out to you?
- **Big Idea:** *"God is looking for who is most available."*
 - On Sunday, Pastor Blake shared how God doesn't look for who is the most qualified, but for whoever is most available.
 - Why doesn't God just choose the people who are the most qualified?
 - What does it mean to be available to God?
 - Pastor Blake shared 5 Ways To Be A Game Changer
 - **Pray First**
 - Why is it important that you pray first?
 - What does it mean to become a vessel of honor?
 - **Look Around**
 - What does it mean to "Look around" spiritually?
 - How can you love the person right in front of you?
 - **Give What You Have**
 - Why is it important to learn to give from what you have now?
 - **Offer A Hand**
 - Why is a community so important in our walk spiritually?
 - Has there been a time in your life when your community helped pick you up?
 - **Expect Big Things**
 - What does it mean to pray "The Best Possible Outcome"?
 - Why is it important that we raise our expectations to match what we see in scripture?

- **Next Steps:** “*Be A Game Changer*”
 - How can you begin to become more available to God today?
 - Which of the 5 Game Changer Steps are you wanting to focus on the most?

Optional Questions – *If needed, include one or more of these scriptures and questions to extend your conversation.*

- Read Acts 3:6 aloud. In this passage, Peter has nothing to give the man physically but offers to give him what he can, prayer and healing.
 - Has God ever used you in a miraculous way before? Or have you ever been on the receiving end of a miracle?
