### **Getting Started**

- **Highs and Lows:** Ask your group what their high point and low point of the week
- **Icebreaker:** What is one place in the world you have to see in your lifetime? Why?

### **Setup**

- Watch Recap Video

### **Key Questions**

- **Review:** What was one thing you did this last week to share your story with others?
- **Recap:** What's one idea that stood out to you from this Sunday's message? Why did that stand out to you?
- **Big Idea:** *"Jesus would undo Consumer Christianity"*
  - On Sunday, Pastor Blake shared how consumerism is the #1 enemy to God's kingdom being advanced.
    - Why is consumerism so dangerous?
    - What are the aspects of consumer Christianity?
  - Pastor Blake shared 3 truths about consumer Christianity
    - **Consumerism Isn't A Calling**
      - Why isn't consumerism a calling?
      - What do you believe are the differences between lay people and clergy?
    - **Church Isn't A Service Provider**
      - What does it mean to view the church as a service provider
      - If the church isn't providing services, who does?
        - Why?
    - **The Customer Isn't King**
      - Why is it important for us to submit our will to God's?

- What does it mean to establish God as the king of our life?
  
- **Next Steps:** *“Live Fully Engaged Because Jesus Is Enough”*
  - What does it mean to live fully engaged?
  - Why is it important that Jesus is enough?
  - How does living fully engaged challenge consumerism?

**Optional Questions** – *If needed, include one or more of these scriptures and questions to extend your conversation.*

- Read **Phillipians 14-15** aloud. In this passage, Paul shares that we should avoid complaining and arguing.
  - Why is Paul urging us to not complain and argue?
  - How would you go about shining like a bright light in your life?
