## Getting Started

## Key Questions

- Review: What was one step you took last week to say yes to God's calling in your life?
- Recap: What's one idea that stood out to you from this Sunday's message? Why did that stand out to you?
- Big Idea: "Jesus would undo Average Christianity"
- On Sunday, Pastor Blake shared that Jesus doesn't call us to have an "average" faith but to have a normal faith. In fact, Jesus was the most normal Christian that ever lived!
- What are the characteristics of an average faith?
- What are the characteristics of a normal faith?
- How does changing the standard for your faith affect how you live?
- Pastor Blake shared 3 ways we can have a normal faith, not simply an average one.
- Make Jesus Our Example
- Why should Jesus be our example for a normal faith instead of people?
- How can he comparison trap harm us when we set others as our example?
- Make Jesus Our Savior
- How does making Jesus our savior help keep us from living a "religious" life?

- Why or why not?
