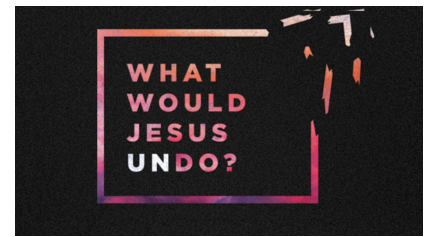


What Would Jesus Undo?

Getting Started

- **Highs and Lows:** Ask your group what their high point and low point of the week
- **Icebreaker:** If you had the ability to do anything (buy an item, take a trip, have an experience) what would it be?

Key Questions

- **Review:** What was one step you took this past week to have a normal faith instead of an average faith?
- **Recap:** What's one idea that stood out to you from this Sunday's message? Why did that stand out to you?
- **Big Idea:** *"Jesus would undo Passive Faith That Changes Nothing "*
 - On Sunday, Pastor Bradley shared that Jesus desires for us to turn from an indifferent, passive faith and pick up a passionate faith.
 - What are the characteristics of a passive faith?
 - What are the characteristics of a passionate faith?

 - Pastor Bradley shared 2 Causes of A Passive Faith
 - **The Illusion of Self-Sufficiency**
 - What is the problem with believing we can handle things on our own?
 - What does it look like to constantly rely on God's strength?
 - **The Distractions of This Life**
 - What are some distractions you are being faced with right now?
 - How do you personally fight through distractions and stay focused on God?

- **Next Steps:** “Every Day, Do Something That Requires Faith”
 - What is one step you can take this week that will require faith?
 - How can we as a group pray for you as you take this step this week?
 - How does daily living by faith begin to change us?

Optional Questions – *If needed, include one or more of these scriptures and questions to extend your conversation.*

- Read **Mark 4:19** aloud. In this passage, Jesus shares how the worries of this life can choke out the word of God in our lives.
 - What are some worries you are facing right now?
 - How can we be praying for you in this situation?
